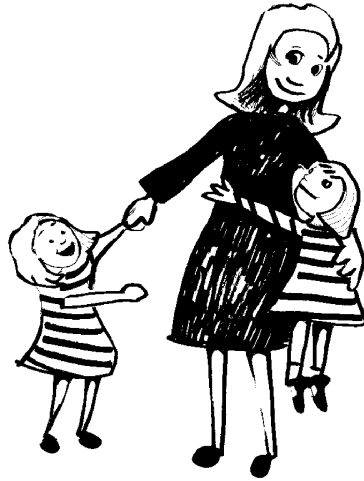

Positive Parenting Services

Private Parent Consultations: individual sessions to work with parents on their specific questions or concerns.

The Warmline Call: a scheduled telephone consultation, one-half hour in length, to answer parents' specific questions or concerns.

School Observations: available when parents and teachers have concerns about a child's development, behavior or adjustment.

Home Visits: observation of parents and children to offer suggestions for effective interactions. Home Visits can also offer suggestions for designing the child's bedroom and home environment to promote independence, self-reliance and learning.

Child Therapy, Family Therapy and Individual Therapy: Leslie Kerr, LCSW offers therapeutic and counseling services for children, adolescents, adults, and families.

Kids' Coaching: a private consultation with children and parents to develop strategies for problem-solving difficult situations.
